What is the Mountain Film Festival?

The Mountain Film Festival, based in Telluride, Colorado, is **America's premier independent documentary film festival**. Each year, a selection of winning films from the week-long international festival are taken on the road to reach audiences who otherwise would not have a chance to experience the festival. The films display themes of adventure, mountaineering, remarkable personalities and important environmental and social messages. Each show is custom-tailored to the venue, event and community in which it is being presented, and is often used as a fundraiser for non-profit organizations.
